GARBAGE DISPOSAL TIPS....

Did you know the garbage disposal is not for "everything" left on your plate?? To keep it clear of obstructions and clogging up try these guidelines:

- ✓ Scrape your plates, pans, bowls in trash with leftover foods on it, then rinse them
- ✓ DO NOT put potato peels, orange rinds, noodles or grease in the garbage disposal.
- ✓ Put extra grease from pans in a jar/container to throw away.
- ✓ Keep it fresh by filling up with ice cubes and grind away.

The correct way to use the garbage disposal:

1. Turn your water on in garbage disposal side of sink
2. Turn on the garbage disposal
3. Put items in garbage disposal
4. Keep running water and garbage disposal for a minute or so after you think it has been ground up.

When overfilling the garbage disposal and then running it, food does not always grind completely up, then clogging the drain as it goes down. Grease, just from rinsing your fry pan after time will build up in the drains and make a sticky sludge that eventually clogs the drains...if you are on the upper floor, the person below you will eventually have a backup in their sink!

WINTER TIPS for Parking




*Santa will be at the zoo seeing children on Fridays and Saturdays through Dec. 23!
